01 Welcome (401 Exit)

Hwy. 401 & County Rd. 2

Exit Hwy. 401 at County Rd. 2 (Exit 461) and drive north past Welcome (Hwy. 10) to view spectacular rolling farmland.

02 Rhino's Roadhouse

5078 Rice Lake Dr., Bewdley

Head east on County Rd. 9 into Bewdley and stop by the celebrated Rhino's Roadhouse for breakfast or lunch with its sunny patio alongside motorcycle parking.

03 Farmland Views

County Rd. 24 (Roseneath to Dartford)

Drive east through Gore's Landing, Harwood and Alderville to County Rd. 24 (near Roseneath) for incredible scenic views. Head east to Dartford and wind your way down beside the old mill pond.

04 Trent River & Trent-Severn Waterway

County Rd. 50, Trent River

Visit the small village of Trent River along the world-famous Trent-Severn Waterway – a 356-km navigable water route with 44 locks through interconnected lakes and rivers in central Ontario.

05 Meyersburg Flea Market & Antiques*

5082 County Rd. 30, Campbellford

Head to Meyersburg since there's always room in the saddlebag for a small treasure like a collectible from Meyersburg Flea Market & Antiques.

06 Village of Warkworth

Main & Mill Sts., Warkworth

Fuel with food or inspiration in the charming Village of Warkworth. You'll see great artisan finds here.

07 Rolling Farmland

Along County Rd. 25

Travel along Hwy. 29 to Hwy. 25 south for a relaxed ride alongside the rolling farmland.

08 Castleton General Store

1768 Percy St., Castleton

Stop at the old Castleton General Store. Feel the floorboards squeak underfoot as you approach one of the original counters for old-fashioned ice cream.

09 Scenic Twists & Turns

Shelter Valley Rd., Grafton

Enjoy the twists and turns of Shelter Valley Road.

10 Rolling Hills & Views

Old Danforth Rd., Grafton & Danforth Rd. E.

Finish your tour by taking Old Danforth Rd. west to Cobourg – one of the best rides on wheels. Get into the rolling rhythm of the Northumberland hills. It feels like a roller coaster ride.

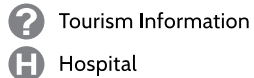

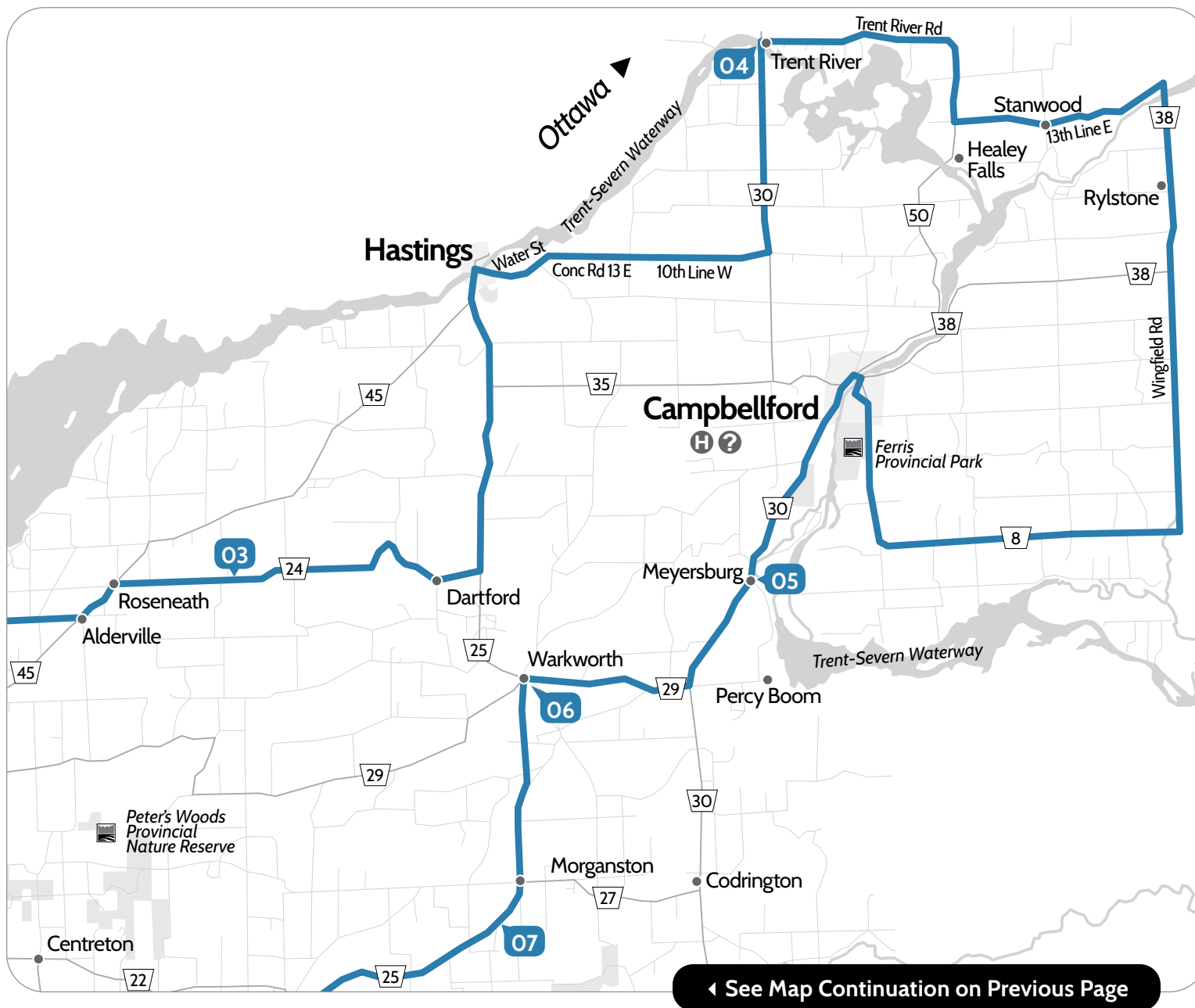
